Wireframes & Flows

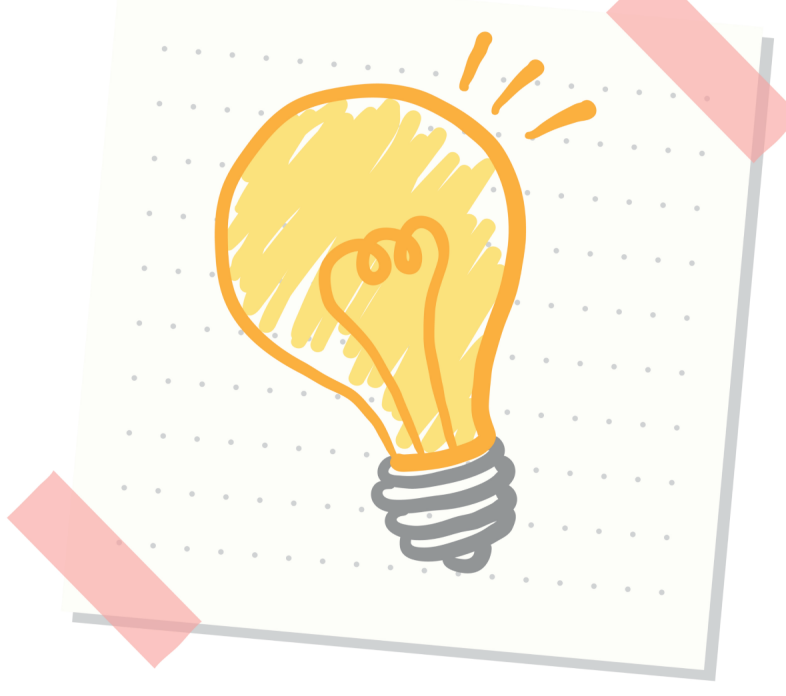
I sketched out a streamlined user journey:

The vibe? Clean, modern, and just a pinch of fun.

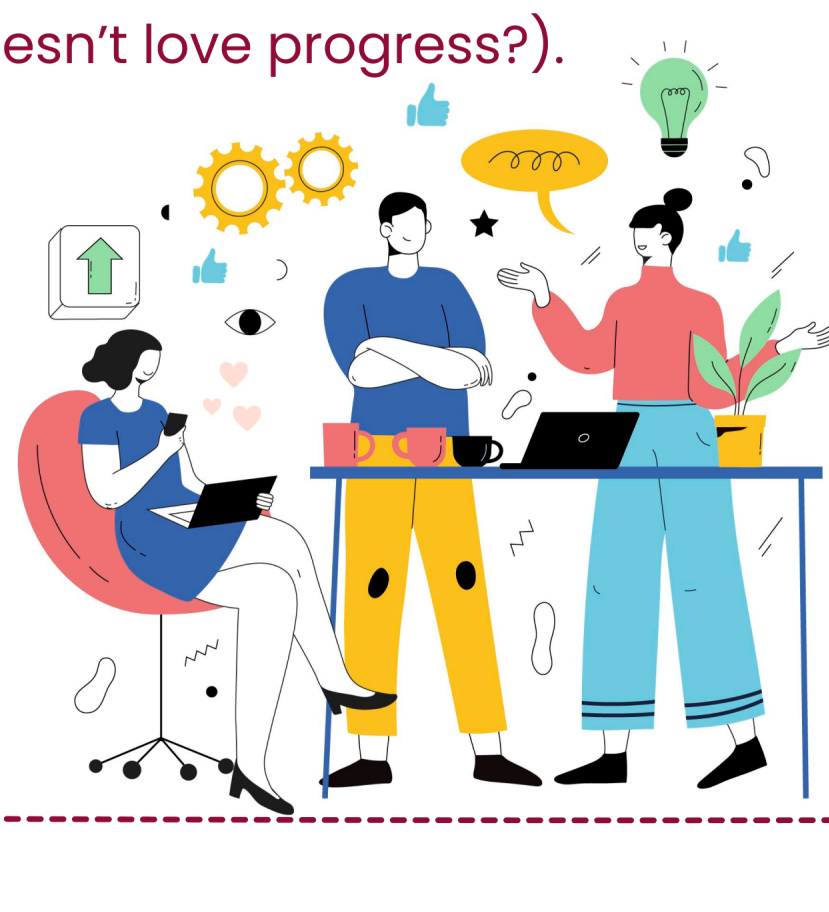
- Colors: Blues and greens for a sense of trust and growth.

Here's what makes this HRMS shine brighter than your favorite highlighter:

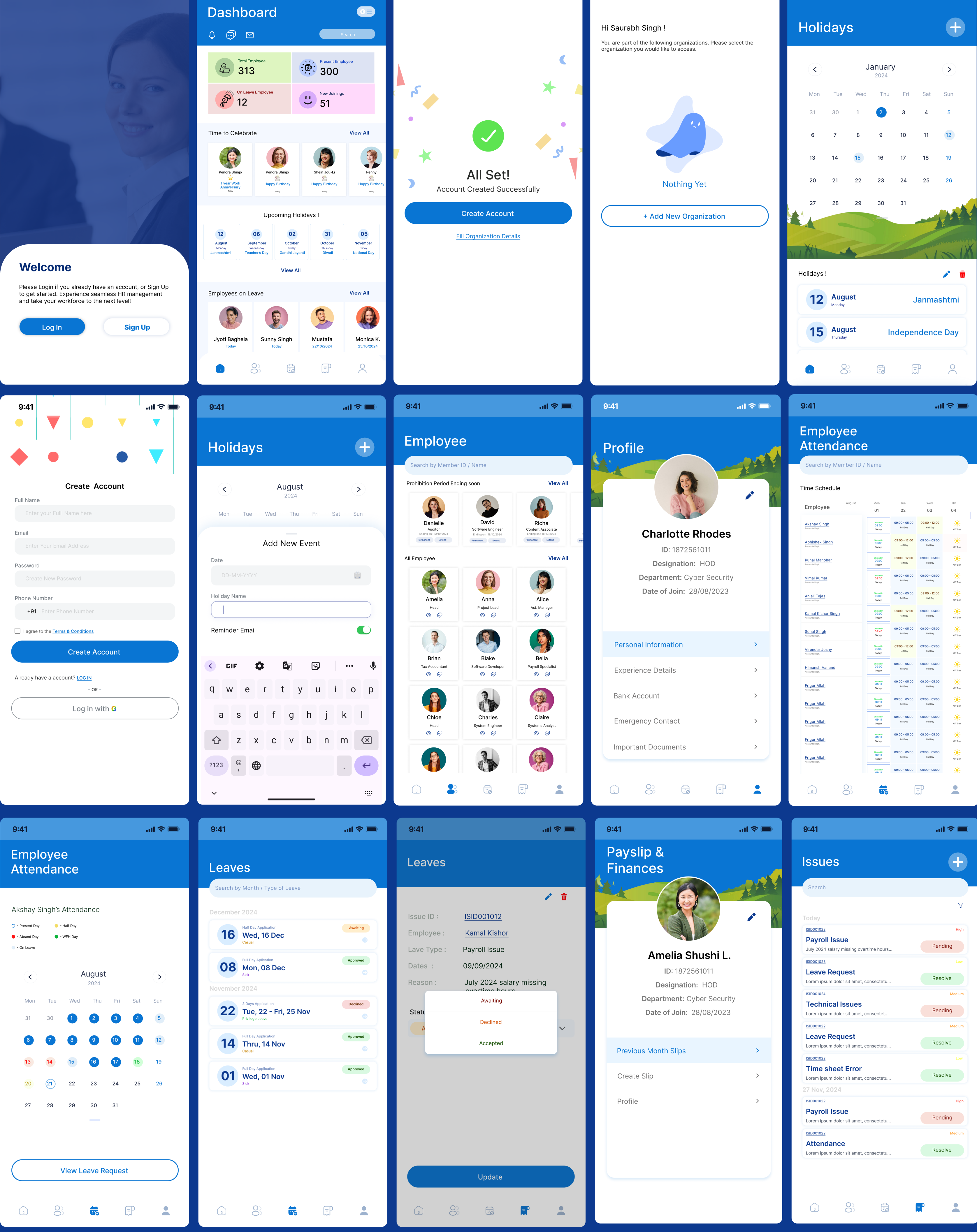
- ✨ **Onboarding:** Automated, paperless, and quick—get employees ready to roll in no time.

- ✨ **Performance Dashboard:** Real-time insights and goal tracking (because who doesn't love progress?).



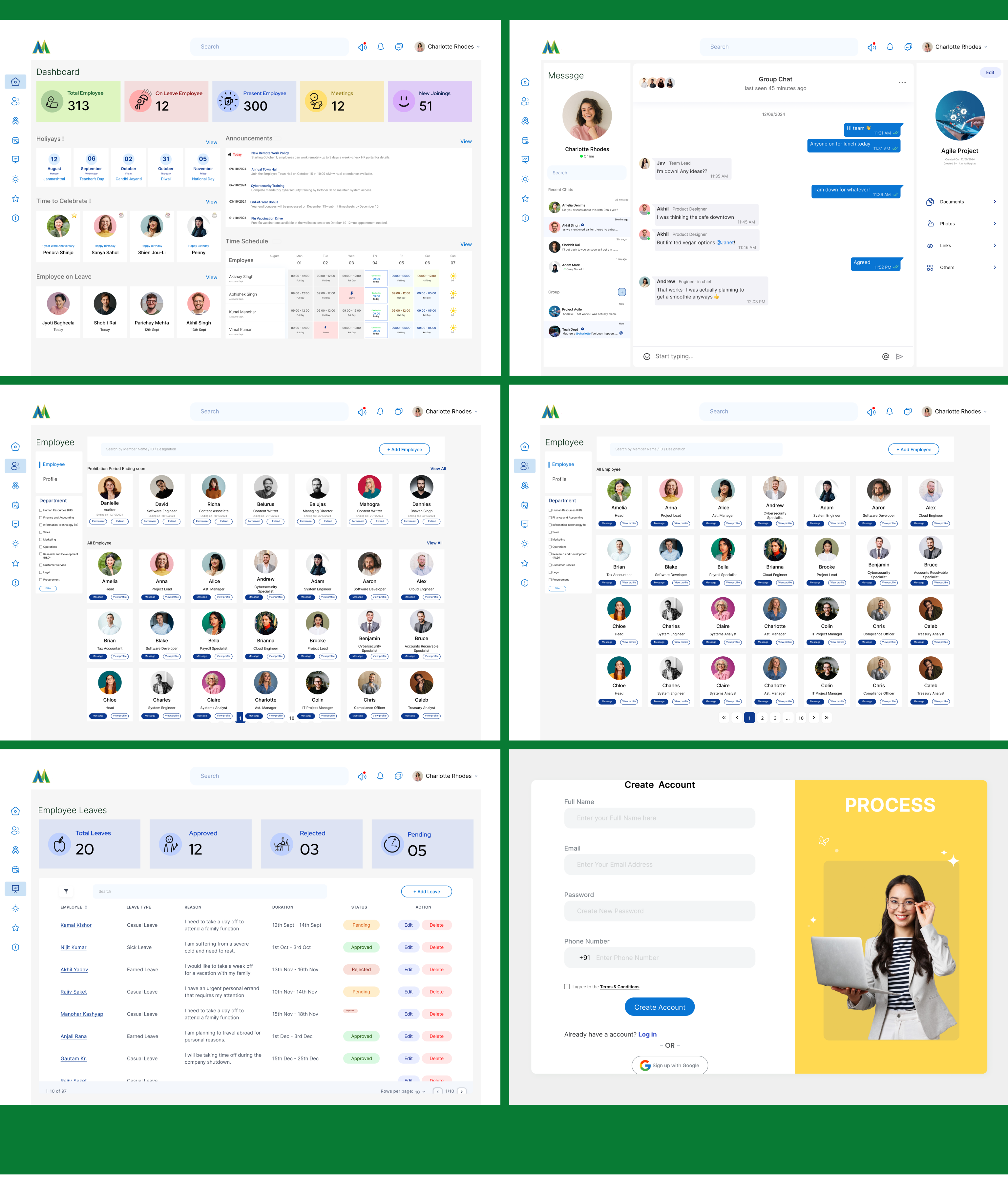
Challenges & Solutions
